Follow Paul's journey across Greece



Paul's journey through Greece moves from the northern port where he entered Europe to cities where his preaching shaped early Christian communities. Walk the Roman roads of Philippi, explore Thessaloniki and Veria, and visit Orthodox monasteries high above Meteora's sandstone pillars. In Athens, stand on the Areopagus where Acts records Paul's address to the city, then enter Ancient Corinth and see the agora and Bema associated with his ministry. Included Greek welcome and farewell dinners place the biblical route within the life of present-day Greece.

Places that frame Paul's journey



Neapolis and Philippi

Trace Paul's arrival in Europe from Kavala, ancient Neapolis, to the Roman roads and early Christian remains of Philippi.



Thessaloniki and Veria

Explore the cities connected with Paul's letters and the Berea account in Acts, from early Christian churches to the memorial in Veria.



The Monasteries of Meteora

Enter Orthodox monasteries built above central Greece's sandstone pillars and see the continuing life of Christian worship.



Athens and Ancient Corinth

Stand on the Areopagus in Athens, then visit the agora, Temple of Apollo, and Bema associated with Paul's ministry in Corinth.



DAYS 1-3 · NORTHERN GREECE

Where Paul's European journey began

1

Welcome to Thessaloniki

Begin in the northern Greek city whose early Christian community received two of Paul's letters. Walk the waterfront and gather for an included Greek welcome dinner.

2

Kavala, Philippi and Amphipolis

Visit Kavala, ancient Neapolis, then walk through Philippi's Roman forum, theatre, basilicas, and traditional sites connected with Lydia and Paul. Pause at ancient Amphipolis before returning to Thessaloniki.

Thessaloniki From the Upper City to the Sea

Look across the city from its upper walls, then visit Vlatadon Monastery, the Rotunda, and the Church of Saint Demetrius before walking the market and waterfront.

DAYS 4 AND 5

From the Berea of Acts to monastic Greece

4

Veria, Aigai and the Road to Meteora

Continue to Veria, the Berea of Acts, and the memorial traditionally associated with Paul's preaching. At Aigai near Vergina, enter the ancient Macedonian capital and royal burial site connected with Philip II and Alexander the Great.

The Monasteries of Meteora

Visit two surviving Meteora monasteries, built high on sandstone pillars above Kalambaka and Kastraki. Their churches, frescoes, and continuing Orthodox communities show how Christian worship continued to shape Greece centuries after Paul.

DAYS 6-8 · ATHENS AND CORINTH

Paul's message in the classical world

6

Athens, the Acropolis and the Areopagus

Climb the Acropolis, stand on the Areopagus where Acts records Paul's address to the Athenians, and walk through Plaka.

Ancient Corinth, Kechries and Epidauros

Walk through Ancient Corinth, pause near Kechries, ancient Cenchreae, and visit the theatre at Epidauros before an included farewell dinner.

A Final Morning in Athens

Enjoy breakfast and a final view of Athens before the included transfer to the airport.

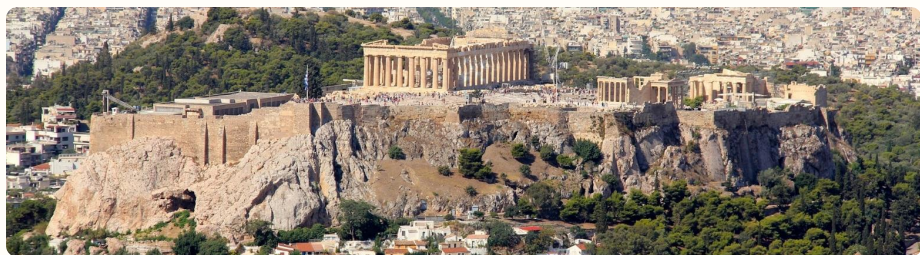
For groups wanting a longer journey, ask about extending the program to Ephesus or Patmos. Routing, timing, and final inclusions are developed around the group.
